Porifera	Ellipse; Polygon	
Cnidaria Actiniaria	circle , mark the disc, not the arms	
Ceriantharia	circle , mark the disc, not the arms	
Stalked Cnidaria	Polygon, os square, including stalk	
Fish	Polygon

Echinoderms Ophiuroidea	Polygon with all arms; or circle around arms	
Asteroidea;	Polygon with all arms; or circle around arms	
Echinoidea	Circle, without the spines	
Holothurians	Ellipse; polygon – use body width	
Xenophyophora	Circle/ellipse	
Crustaceans Decapoda	Crab - Elipse, covering tórax Shrimp -	
Shrimp;	Elipse, full length;	
Unkown	Polygon
